



Come Early for Coffee with the Mayors



Karl Mooney

College Station Mayor In 1989, Karl Mooney moved to College Station from his home state of New Jersey, and he has been heavily involved in the community ever since. He has served on the Planning and Zoning Commission, the Transportation and Mobility committee, and the Economic Development committee, as well as serving for six years on the city council. In November, Mooney was elected mayor of College Station. Outside of city government, Mooney works with Texas A&M University as director of General Academic Programs Advising.

Coming from a background of urban planning, Mooney sees development and infrastructure as some of the biggest issues the city faces. College Station is expanding, and Mooney's goal is to try to limit its growing pains.

"We have traffic: everyone complains about the traffic," says Mooney. "Then we have infrastructure. Especially on Northgate and around that area, what you don't see underneath the road and the ground is the limited amount of piping and electric lines."

The community itself has changed over the years, says Mooney. In some neighborhoods where only two-bedroom houses existed there are now four-bedroom houses being built. This reflects both an expanding population and an increasing age range. Mooney says the

city is looking at developing a community center that appeals to all ages, as well as a new community pool since the last city pool was built in 1993.

The mayor's vision includes the city tackling public safety, particularly through a reinvigoration of neighborhood watches and citizen participation in keeping the city safe.

"One of the things we need to do is work with our police, and not only the police here, but also the university," says Mooney.



Andrew Nelson

Bryan Mayor Andrew Nelson has been a part of the Bryan College Station community for most of his life. He attended Texas A&M University and studied mechanical engineering, graduating Cum Laude in 1992. He's raised his family in Bryan and also built his business into a globespanning company.

Nelson has worn many hats in his time in Bryan. He is a board member of the Bryan Rotary Club, has spent five years on the Bryan Business Council, a year on the city's Comprehensive Planning Committee, volunteers at his church and with the Boy and Girl Scouts of America, among others. He is now also Bryan's mayor.

"I love serving; I have a passion for service," Nelson savs. "I love Bryan, and feel bringing a business perspective to the strategy for the city with 900 employees and a \$400 million budget is very important to moving the city forward."

As mayor, Nelson wants to see the city become a place where recent graduates can come to start their lives and raise their families, much how he did. To do this, he

says that the city needs to work hard on renovating its infrastructure and expanding its workforce. Nelson's goal is to keep taxes low while invigorating Bryan.

"I want to be the mayor that helps Downtown Bryan to move from having a First Friday to just 'Friday,'" says Nelson. "I want every day in Bryan to be like First Friday."

Nelson says that Bryan is connected to Texas A&M much in the same way as College Station. In addition to supporting the university's growth, Nelson says he wants Bryan to support and expand its workforce through trade schools, encouraging education and entrepreneurship, and finding ways to create jobs.

"We want those entrepreneurs to stay here. We need to give them a community where the 22-32 age range can start their lives and find a sense of place."

Speaker Preview



Jim Gaines

Chief Economist, The Real Estate Center, Texas A&M University

Jim Gaines is well known for providing a torrent of statistics to back up the real estate economist's straight talk about trends in local, state, and national market growth. Making his eighth appearance at the Economic Outlook Conference, Gaines says one of the key things he will be talking about in the first quarter of 2017 is "rising optimism — awaiting reality."

Gaines explains: "The economy reflects the feelings and anticipation of the market. A number of economic indicators, such

as the stock market and manufacturing have been up, although manufacturing is still not a big thing. Main street anticipation is that the new administration is going to be more pro business with a decrease in regulatory burdens, lower corporate taxes, and otherwise be more helpful to business.

"My take on all of this even with the administration and congress trying to move in these directions — it will probably take a year or two for real significant changes to take impact.

"My last take on it, no matter what, is the reality may not live up to the expectations for everyone," adds Gaines.

Locally, Gaines says he hopes a slowdown in growth won't greatly affect Texas A&M University's budget coming out of the legislature. "In Bryan College Station, growth for most of the past several years has been frenetic," says Gaines. "No market this size can go at that pace all the time."

Even statewide, the slowdown hasn't been as bad as what some thought it might be, adds Gaines. "Oil's collapse was bigger percentagewise than the drop during the Eighties. What we're seeing is a lot more resiliency around the state of being more diversified."

Overall, Gaines says 2017 is going to be a very good year in the Brazos Valley, maybe not quite as strong as 2014, 2015 and 2016, but strong nevertheless... assuming the university doesn't have draconian budget cuts.



Glenn Hegar Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts

In his role as Texas' chief financial officer - the state's treasurer, check writer, tax collector, procurement officer and revenue estimator -Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts Glenn Hegar has an overview of the economic drivers and challenges ahead in 2017. Hegar will be sharing insights from that perspective as the keynote speaker for the Bryan College Station Chamber of Commerce **Economic Outlook Conference** on Jan. 25.

Texas is the world's 10th largest economy, notes Hegar, and while last year's downturn in the mining and oil and gas industries has affected Texas' economy overall, Texas has continued to gain jobs overall. In particular, the economy in Bryan College Station has continued to perform well.

As Hegar's office prepares the revenue forecast for the upcoming Texas legislative session, Hegar says he will be able to address the expected growth rate overall over the next two-year cycle. Locally, he points to the presence of Texas A&M University as an economic stabilizer for the local economy, a resource of many "hidden gems" that contribute economic stimulus locally.

Hegar says the keynote address in January will be an opportunity to hear about not only local indicators, but also the ways that Texas, statewide, is a great economic opportunity.

Elected in November 2014, Hegar is a sixthgeneration Texan, who grew up farming land that has been in his family since the mid-1800s. Before becoming Comptroller, Hegar served in the Texas House of Representatives and the Texas Senate, and also served as chair of the Sunset Advisory Commission, which works to eliminate inefficiency in government agencies. Hegar attended Texas A&M as an undergraduate, where he earned a Bachelor of Arts. He then attended St. Mary's University, earning a Master of Arts and his law degree. At the University of Arkansas, he earned a Master of Laws degree. Glenn and his wife Dara have three young children — Julia, Jonah and Claire.


HEATING UP THE KITCHEN

50 Men Who Can Cook

↑ That originally started as a small fundraiser has become a night of food and fun that brings the entire community together. This February marks the 10th anniversary of 50 Men Who Can Cook, a charity event hosted by the College Station ISD Education Foundation.

"One of our board members, about 10 vears ago, saw this done in a different state," says Teresa Benden, director of the CSISD Education Foundation for seven years. "My predecessor, Anne Ganter, and some board members came up with the idea [based on that event]."

The event has shown tremendous growth over the years. Originally, 50 Men Who Can Cook was a relatively intimate wine pairing event. The first event had about 300 people in attendance and 50 chefs. This year, however, 2,000 people are expected to attend and 70 chef booths will be presenting their meals.

As the name suggests, the chefs are all male. They are also local business owners and members of the community. Cooking for this event is typically invite-only, says Benden, but some people step forward to volunteer. Some of the chefs this year will be College Station Police Chief Scott McCollum, CSISD Superintendent Dr. Clark Ealy, Tom Turbiville of radio station

WTAW, and former sports journalist for The Eagle Larry Bowen.

"It's a great organization," says Chief McCollum, who has been a participating chef for the past five years. "They do a lot for our kiddos, so we're happy to help out. It's always a fun night, a really great event."

When the chefs sign up they choose their recipe; anything they want," says Benden. "What we ask them to do is bring 800 or more bite-sized samples of whatever they cook. It could be anything from a dessert, to an entrée, to an appetizer."

People attending the event will be encouraged to sample as much as they can, and to vote on their favorites.

Wine, beer, and margaritas will also be available and included in the ticket price. There will also be a photobooth, \$20 grab

bags, a silent auction, and a raffle. One of the big items up for grabs at the raffle is a diamond double halo pendant donated by David Gardner's Iewelers, valued at \$5,000.

"Last year we netted \$205,000," says Benden. "We would like to raise \$225,000 this year."

All proceeds raised by 50 Men Who Can Cook will be divided among several programs hosted by the CSISD Education Foundation, such as innovative teaching grants, student scholarships, the Success 24/7 instructional website, and a senior hall of fame banquet.

This event is considered private, and tickets will not be available at the door the night of the event. Those wishing to go must purchase their tickets ahead of time. Tickets are \$60 per person and are all-inclusive. VIP tickets are also available to special sponsors of the event, allowing them early access. While everybody is welcome, 50 Men Who Can Cook is considered an adults-only event. Held on Feb. 3 at the Brazos County Expo, doors open at 6:30 p.m., but VIPs will be able to get in a half-hour early. Tickets are available at givetokids.csisd.org or by texting 50Men to 41444. Board members and celebrity chefs will also have tickets available to sell. i

LIGHTS OFF **DINING IN THE DARK 2017**

Imagine dining where there is no light and you can only hear or feel what's around you.



In February, the Brazos Valley Center for Independent Living will host the 5th Annual Dining in the Dark event to raise awareness about low vision and blindness while promoting the full inclusion and participation of people with disabilities in all aspects of community life. The dinner also serves as a reminder that individuals who have visual impairments are hard working members of society just like any other individual.

The event format includes dinner served in the dark by servers who are blind or have low vision. The meal is served and eaten in the dark, which presents both the servers and guests with a unique challenge. It also provides a journey for the other senses as the dinner is an opportunity for everyone, disabled or not, to come together and learn about one another without the ability to see their surroundings. During the event, no one will be seen; communication is accomplished through feeling, hearing, or speaking to one another. The multi-course menu (appetizer, main course, and dessert) will not be revealed to the guests until the end of the event.

The BVCIL first hosted this event in 2013 as a means of starting a major fundraiser. Shelby Catron, office assistant and volunteer coordinator of the BVCIL, says it was also a great way to get the community to start talking about blindness and the abilities of individuals with different levels of vision impairment. Since 2014, the event has been hosted at the College Station Hilton.

The dinner experience is provided by volunteers who have signed up and received training for their specific job assignments. Servers must be able to navigate in the dark and be willing to educate guests about their disability. Other volunteer opportunities include setup crew, raffle and silent auction, cart runners, seaters, and guest escorts.

While the people who participate in this event may have other disabilities, or in some cases none at all, all the servers who take part in the event are people who have some form of vision impairment. It's a way to show that these individuals can still do things just like anyone else, Catron explains.



The event starts at 6 p.m. and usually begins with a social hour. In addition to live music by Drew Womack, there is a silent auction, a chance to purchase raffle tickets for highly soughtafter items, and a cash bar. There is also a sensory room hosted by Texas A&M Disability Services, which gives guests a chance to learn a place setting in the dark, learn how to identify money without vision, and other sensory tasks.

continues. the As the event auests will have an opportunity to utilize their other senses while getting to know their server. The servers are given the opportunity to tell their stories and talk with guests about how they navigate their daily life. Guests are given the opportunity to learn about disabilities and gain new perspective.

During an evening like no other, Catron says the guests are always surprised to learn of their server's abilities while having a vision impairment or blindness. The praise the servers receive is always positive. "It provokes people to be

excited and spread [awareness]," she says. The conversation continues as the dinner ends and the lights come on. The guests are then given time to ask more questions of the entire staff of servers about their experiences.

The event may be geared toward blindness awareness, but it is open to the public and anyone who wants to experience something different is invited to attend. Catron says to expect a full house. Buying tickets early is strongly recommended. The dinner is a great way of promoting the hardworking people of the Brazos Valley who may have disabilities and still get the job done, just like anyone else, Catron says, adding that the servers are appreciative because they get the opportunity to prove their abilities while educating others.

Powersports Cheerleading

Bows are straightened, skirts are adjusted, and pompoms are shaken out as the cheerleaders assume their places for the routine. As the music blares. Kristen Marez's mother pushes her across the blue mat with a poster board attached to her wheelchair that reads "Round Off Back Handspring Double Full."

"That was only our third time with the music!" says longtime gymnastics coach Julie Dujka of their practice.

Two years ago, Dujka started a cheerleading program for people with special needs at Powersports gym, a program that accepts people across the spectrum of special needs for a registration fee of \$30.

Initially, Dujka says she threw out the idea to coach both private gymnastics and cheerleading classes and would direct the kids to whichever program they wanted to join.

The class has grown from eight people to 11 over the last two years with girls ranging from ages 6 to 21 with all different kinds of personalities and needs.

Girls gain confidence and strength above all else when they join the program.

"I see confidence and joy in them [as they cheer]," says Dujka. "It's seeing them beam whenever they come into the gym and knowing they have a family here. I don't call it [physical] therapy, it's just an activity for these girls."

The parents of the girls participating in the program bring them to practices every Friday and stay to watch.

Brandis Tomalá, mother of cheerleader Izzy Tomalá, gets emotional when she talks about what Powersports has done for her daughter.

"Three years ago she couldn't even talk, and now she's talking, laughing, and cheerleading." says Tomalá,

Kristen Marez is non-verbal and non-mobile, but her face lights up whenever her mother, Jennifer, mentions cheerleading. "[She] has gained so much more physical strength," says Jennifer.

The program has created a bridge between the cheerleading community and the special needs community as girls get to help show other girls how to do different moves and stunts.

"I am able to have helpers from other [Powersports cheer teams] come



in and volunteer and it brings unity to [Powersports] gym," Dujka says.

Helpers must be 9 years old or older; each girl has her own helper.

"My [daughters] have a heart and compassion for kids with special needs," says Monica Sigler, mother of three helpers. "They are just drawn to them and want to help and cheer with them; it's amazing. My daughter Reese even did a talent show with an autistic girl. She came up with routines and everything. That takes a lot of patience and maturity for a 10-vear-old."

Dujka's two daughters, Kalyn and Nadia, have been helping with the program since it started along with participating in gymnastics and cheerleading.

"It's been really rewarding to go home with my girls and know we did this together," says Dujka.



MILITARY & TRADITION

Cavalry Court Hotel Offers New Old Experience

ack the Australian Shepherd, mascot of the Cavalry Court Hotel, happily greets customers. He sits in the check-in lounge, AKA The Guardhouse. When Marcus Latner walks by, Jack quickly jumps up to follow him everywhere. The dog is far from the only attraction the new hotel has to offer.

Latner is Cavalry Court's general manager; he has been in the hotel business for 14 years. He started off in San Antonio with the Valencia Group as part of the group that got the city's Hotel Valencia off the ground. He came to College Station for Cavalry Court, which opened in November, and The George,™ which will open in the spring.

Credit for the original design of a "retro-styled court brand" goes to the current Valencia president Doyle Graham, Jr., Latner explains. Graham's vision was a timeless retro military-style design featuring modern, luxury amenities. Like the motor courts of yesteryear, the goal is to capture a throwback to a time when travel was an adventure and to embrace a bit of Americana.

Cavalry Court's unique design inspires tradition and camaraderie

Cavalry Court is spread out over four acres, and was built as two- and threestory buildings surrounding a large courtyard, which features a swimming pool, grills and tables, a fire pit, and several places for hotel guests to meet and relax.

The hotel has a unique style. Owned and developed by Midway and the Valencia Group, Cavalry Court was built with the history and flavor of the local community in mind. Cavalry Court was designed to create a sense of place that

inspires tradition and camaraderie and resembles an old military training camp. The hotel's carefully curated blend of colors, fabrics, textures, and materials were developed by designers Rottet Studio. Cavalry Court's retro military design from the '50s and '60s is in homage to Texas A&M University's history as a military school.

Cavalry Court ends the military metaphor at comfort. The hotel comes with the very best amenities, and is designed to have something for everyone. The rooms at Cavalry Court are not much bigger than the standard hotel room size, but several features make it feel big and luxurious. For one, unlike most chain hotels with the restroom near the front door. the bathroom is set at the far end of the room. The walk-in shower also feels much larger than the cramped conditions of a chain hotel. The bathroom is accessed via sliding barn doors, and large windows on both sides of the room let in lots of natural light. The main room also comes with a fully stocked 1950's style refrigerator and snack bar served out of a "refurbished"

ammunition crate. The prices of this mini bar are also lower than at other hotel chains, Latner says. They keep prices closer to what one would find in a grocery store or at a bar. The room also comes with free wifi, a sturdy writing desk, and a TV where Netflix, Hulu, and other forms of entertainment can be accessed.

"It's great for the parents to come and visit the kids because now they've got somewhere fun to stay," says Latner. "Once again, especially during the week, groups and business travelers are our biggest clientele, so we made sure to appeal to them as well."

For those staying for business purposes, Cavalry Court offers large conference rooms and meeting places. Latner says they are perfect for almost any event, from meetings to weddings. These are designed to feel like repurposed barns, where horses may have once been kept. The ceilings are vaulted with lots of natural light. The wooden interior also fits in well with the retro, country feeling of the hotel.

The hotel offers a free continental breakfast every day at the canteen, a building that looks like a mix between an army mess hall and a modern coffee house. All this, plus the attractions in the central courtyard, are meant to make the hotel a fun and memorable part of customers' trips.

"We really believe there is a demand for a unique, fun luxury hotel," says Latner. "That's what we're providing. There's a demand, but no one's been able to capture the ambiance until now."

While prices will vary depending on time, party size, and even the football season, Latner says he wants to keep room rates from \$169 a night.

It's located at the new regional destination, Century Square, under development by Midway in conjunction with Texas A&M University. Set on University Drive, Texas A&M is right across the street from the hotel.

Northgate is also only a few blocks away, though as more and more businesses move into the new area. restaurants and entertainment will be even closer.

Latner says many of the people involved with Cavalry Court are Texas A&M alumni. He sees it as a way of keeping business local, as well as a way to give back to the community.

Their Story

The sisters had a different plan before stumbling upon the junking lifestyle. They grew up in East Texas, in a small town called Overton. Bryan/College Station also holds a special place in their heart.

Amie graduated from Texas A&M in 1995 with a degree in agriculture journalism. After graduating, Amie packed her bags and moved down the road to Austin, where she worked in the Texas State Capitol for three years and eventually applied for law school. However, she knew law school just wasn't for her, so she turned down her acceptance and moved back home. Amie worked part-time at the family pizza restaurant and slowly built what would one day become Junk Gypsy.


Jolie graduated from Texas A&M in 1997 with a bachelor's degree in biomedical sciences. She worked as a teacher in Houston for a couple of years before returning to College Station to work on a master's degree in health education, which she received in 2003. While earning her master's, she worked as an academic advisor for Sports Management.

During this time, their father was diagnosed with leukemia. Jolie quit her job and would drive back and forth from College Station to Overton to help out part-time with the family business. Not long after, the entire Sikes family moved to College Station. They lived here around 10 years working and growing Junk Gypsy.

Many of the early Junk Gypsy business meetings were held at the sisters' favorite locale, the Dixie Chicken. While they may not use their Aggie degrees for the intended purposes, the time they spent at Texas A&M has had a direct impact on their business.

"The skills you learn at A&M are such lifelong skills," says Jolie. "Loyalty and the traditions at A&M are so important. We were raised with that sense of community. To this day it's part











of the life blood of Junk Gypsy ... it's more than a business; it's a community, a lifestyle. That's how A&M is. It's part of who you are. ... You live, eat, and breathe it. That's how Junk Gypsy is."

The Business

Amie and Jolie started out selling t-shirts and junking wherever they went. Now, the sisters sell everything from clothes and jewelry to repurposed "junk" and household items. They also take on some bigger projects for celebrity friends, like Miranda Lambert, Billie Joe Armstrong, and Sadie Robertson.

The Sikes always have their hands in more than one project at a time, all while maintaining a hands-on approach to their business. "We never sit down and say, "This is your job, and this is your job," says Amie. "We start working, and it just all works out. We both just work. We are both dedicated to the end goal for Junk Gypsy and our family to be successful and happy. If [Jolie] needs help on something, she will say so. Otherwise we are just forging on."

After five years setting up at flea markets. Amie and Iolie decided it was time to put down roots. Ultimately, their hearts led them to Round Top. "We needed to be in the country," Jolie says of the move. "A lot of people consider College Station a small town, but for us it was big. [Round Top] was kind of like home already with the antiques shows. It was calling to us. It felt like it was meant to be."

They bought the land, which is now a 60-acre compound, and broke ground on the Junk Gypsy HQ. The store opened in the fall of 2013 and has been thriving since.

Round Top is home to Texas Antiques Week twice a year. Junk Gypsy participates, and the sisters can be found at the store, at their tent, or junking themselves. During the week, they throw their legendary Junk-O-Rama Prom at Zapp Hall, where all walks of life come to drink, dance, and show off their unique vintage prom dresses and western wear. The next Antiques Week is March 22 through April 2.

The Show

The first episode of Junk Gypsies premiered on HGTV on Nov. 11, 2011. In the first season, Amie and Jolie conquered Antiques Week, Dierks Bentley's Airstream, Junk-O-Rama Prom, and various home projects for families and friends across Texas.

Amie and Jolie were initially skeptical about starring in their own TV show.

"Production companies started calling 12 years ago," Jolie explains. "They all just wanted us to be the female version of American Choppers. ... Everyone wanted us to argue; it was something we had no interest in. Then about five years into everyone calling us, our current producer called us. We trusted her."

Because it was more of a lifestyle show, season two and three were moved to GAC. They have taken a hiatus from filming while working on some of their other projects, but they haven't called it quits on the show. Jolie says they will keep everyone posted.

The Book

Last year, Amie and Jolie released their first book, "Junk Gypsy: Designing a Life at the Crossroads of Wonder & Wander." The seven-month project tells stories, gives DIY inspiration, and shares some of their favorite projects.

The book is divided up into three sections: "The road: where we get our inspiration. The flea market: where practical magic meets elbow grease. Home: where our hearts are."

The book is also a love letter to their fans and supporters over the last 20 years.

"To the dedicated, true-blue, boot-stompin' IG warriors who've been around since the beginning: Pull up a chair and stay awhile," the introduction reads. "We could never thank you enough. We've worked hard to keep this book as authentic to our JG spirit as you would expect it to be. We want you to love it. Highlight, dog-ear, and doodle in the margins. Take notes and tuck them in your mirror frame. This book is for you."

The 230-page passion project is packed with pictures, inspiration, and heart-warming tales, not to mention the DIY projects for dreamers who want to take a stab at it themselves. The book isn't just for long-time fans or DIY junkies. Anyone can pick up the book and feel like family by the end of it: "Now that you're part of our family, we look forward to the moment when our wandering paths cross yours again."

The Inn

The biggest project on the radar for the Junk Gypsies is The Wander Inn. Comprised of two buildings on the back of the property in Round Top, it is expected to open early this year.

"It's very special back there," Jolie says. "You feel like you're in another world." Adds Amie, "I wanted it to feel like big open space and big sky country. The way the land lays, you couldn't even see any of the store."

The inspiration for the Inn came from the Chisholm Trail and the Texas Independence Trail, both of which run through or near the area. The interior is a mix of Americana, Rock 'n Roll, and Western. Each room has a different theme, but the space as a whole fits together cohesively to provide a warm and inviting environment. "It's going to be a place where people come for an experience," Amie says. "People will come as strangers and leave as friends."

The project has been particularly special for Amie. "What we always say about Junk Gypsy is that you're going to find that thing you never knew you needed. The Wander Inn feels like that for me," she says. "I never realized how much I would love it. I really think when I'm 80 years old, I'll still be out there building fires for people. ... I can't imagine Junk Gypsy without it."

In March, Amie and Jolie will set sail with Country Living on the Country Living Coast-to-Coast Caribbean Cruise.

















The cruise stops at Turks & Caicos Islands; San Juan, Puerto Rico; St Maarten; and the Bahamas. As the cruise's special guests, Amie and Jolie will hold DIY demonstrations and a Junk Gypsy Prom. Junking and antiquing expeditions are available at some of the stops.

The cruise will be a family affair, and they've made special preparations including Mason jar shaped pool floats.

Neither sister has been to any of the places the cruise will stop, but Amie sees the whole trip as a reflection on how far they have come. "To go from [\$2,000 and an old truck] to getting paid to go on a cruise with Country Living is kind of phenomenal and unbelievable," she says.

The Road Goes on Forever...

The sisters don't have to live in College Station for Texas A&M and Bryan College Station to still be important parts of who they are.

"Number one is the Dixie Chicken – always and forever," Jolie says. "We love campus; every time we are in town, we go to the MSC and hang out in the flag room. I just love College Station."

Amie tries to come to one of her other favorite places at least once a year. "I like going and staying at the LaSalle in Bryan and going to do all the stuff in Downtown Bryan," she says. She also makes a point to visit campus with her daughter, Indie, whenever she can.

Neither can resist the traditions that are part of the Aggie family, including football.

"The fact that there are traditions is amazing," Jolie gushes. "I cannot help it, every time the Aggie Band is on the field, or talking about them, there is something about them... it is just so regal."

For Amie, midnight yell will always hold a special place in her heart. "I went Friday night to midnight yell, and I was sold," she explains. "That's when I became an Aggie, was midnight yell. I was in tears; I was over the moon. There are a lot of midnight vells I've forgotten, but I've never forgotten that one."

Amie and Jolie leave inspiration and a whole lot of glitter trailing behind them wherever they go. They are nowhere near hitting the brakes. As Robert Earl Keen says, "The road goes on forever, and the party never ends." i
